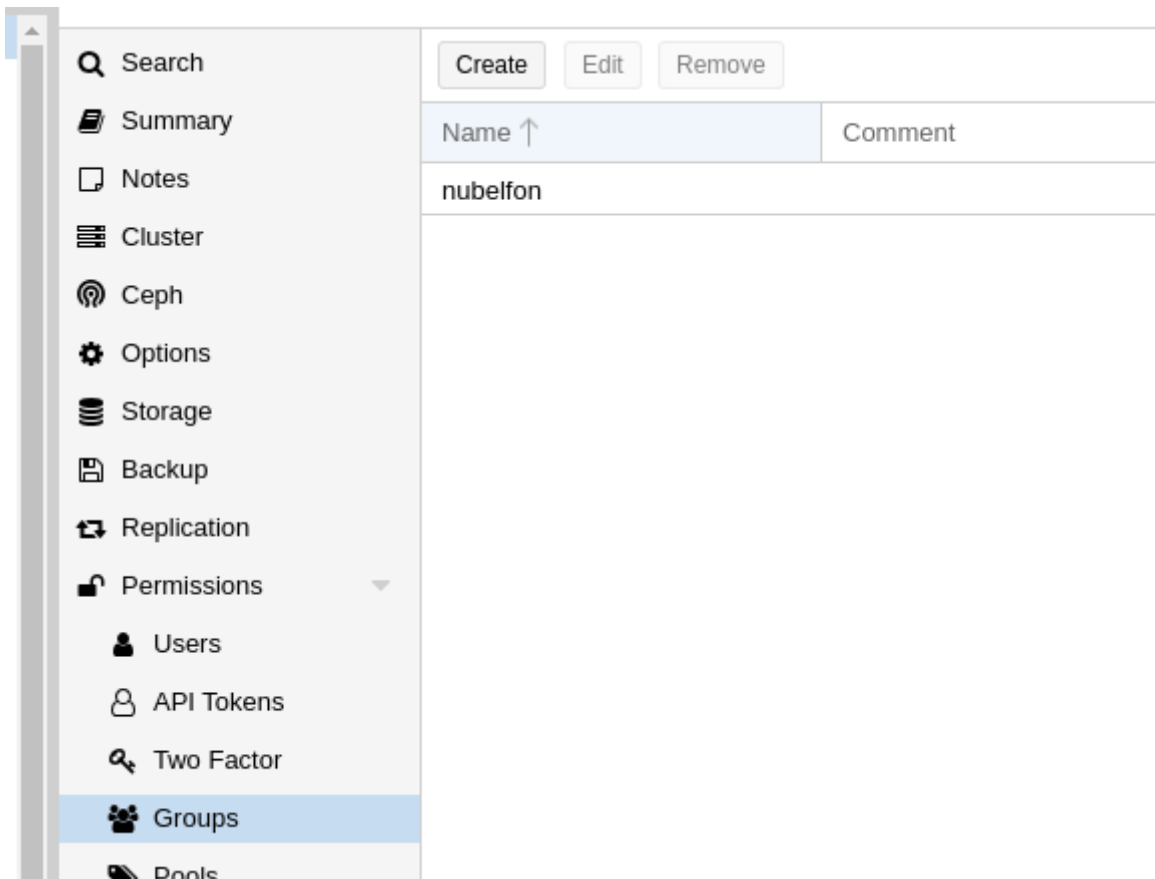



Alta del acceso en hoteles

1. Creamos un nuevo grupo en Datacenter -> permissions -> groups



2. Añadimos un nuevo permiso concreto al grupo que hemos creado antes en Datacenter -> permissions:




